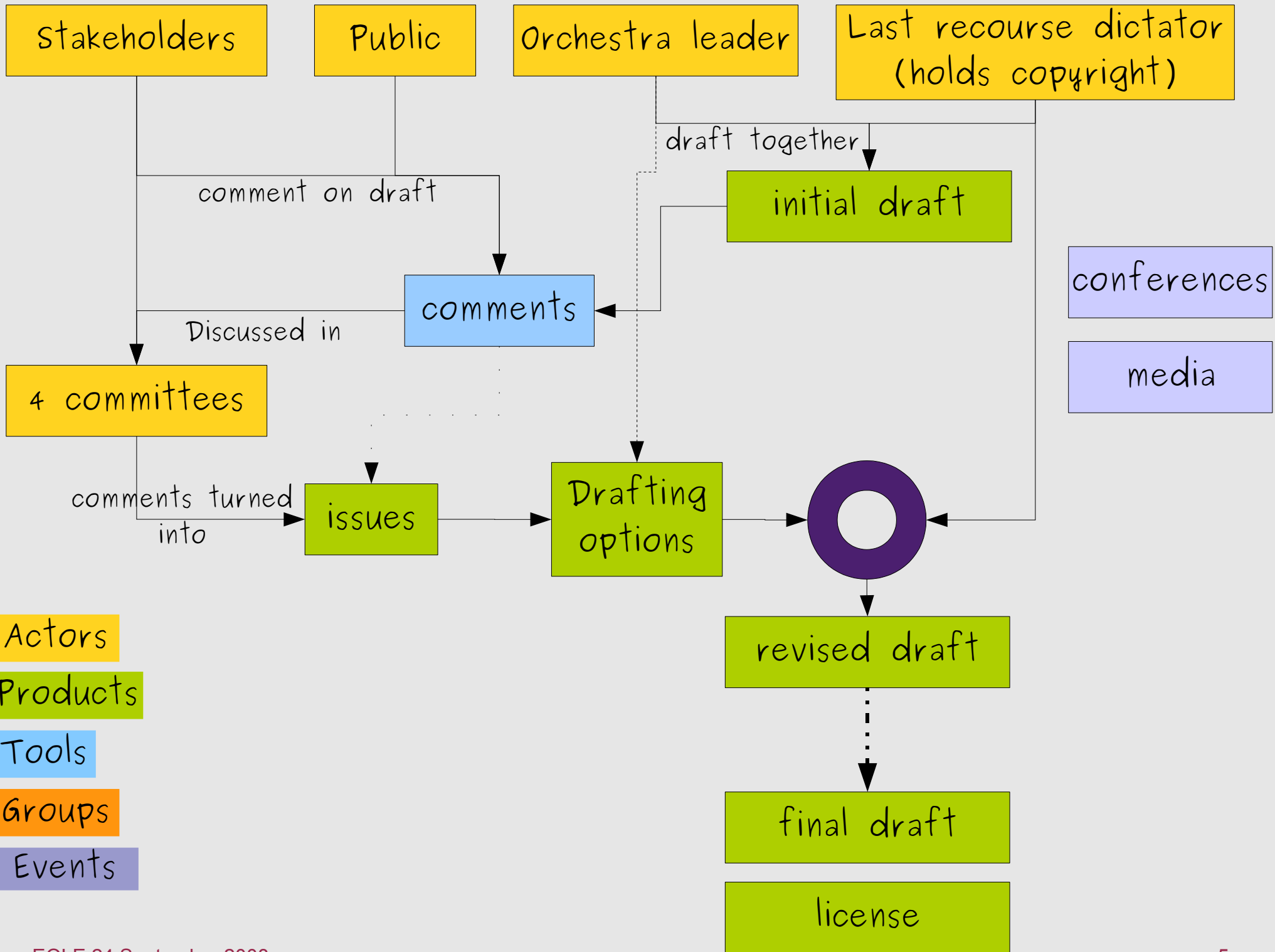
A unique multi-stakeholder global governance

ggravier: Isn't this actually in contradiction with the OSI definition of Open Source at : http://www.opensource.org/docs/osd which states :


"6. No Discrimination Against F...[+]
